Judge Mark Fuller, who convicted Gov. Siegelman, is currently being considered for impeachment. Judge Fuller's August 2014 arrest for beating his wife resulted in a special panel review by the 11<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals. The Judiciary Committees in both the House and the Senate are awaiting the results of this review. Funding for an impeachment investigation has been requested.

In 2002, Gov. Siegelman and Judge Fuller had a series of serious political conflicts. Fuller never should have been allowed to preside over Gov. Siegelman's case.

Gov. Siegelman has appealed for a new trial and is awaiting the decision from the 11<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals. A new trial with an unbiased judge could exonerate him. Our government owes him a fair trial or a full pardon. The truth will certainly set him free.

4. And finally, be sure to include the full address of the White House to make sure your message gets to us as quickly and directly as possible:
